



In the cases wherein the water used for Domestic/Agricultural use exceeds 15% in each case the excess use shall be charged at Industrial applicable rate specified in clause II of this agreement. - c) The Industrial water requirement, the Domestic water requirement and agricultural (nursery/gardening) water requirement of the company as demanded deemed to be separate and independent for the sole purpose and water charges assessment shall be accordingly separate and independent for other clauses of this agreement.
- The permission hereby granted shall be subject to the provisions of the Maharashtra Irrigation Act 1976 and the Bombay Canal Rules 1934 and subsequent revision, if any, in force and any Executive orders issued in this behalf by Government and any statutory amendment thereof From time to time and for the time being in force.
- Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to imply any guarantee on the part of the Government as to the availability or otherwise of any specific quantity of water and Government shall not be responsible for the non-supply or in adequate supply of water on any account whatsoever.

 However in case of inadequate or non-supply due to shortage of water or reason beyond

the control of the Department, bill shall be charged as per actual quantity of water <u>lifted</u> / <u>supplied</u> during such period.

4) The company shall use the water drawn from the said river for purposes of the company's said plant and for supply to the residential colonies constructed by the company within the area of the said plant for providing housing to its employees and workers (hereinafter referred to as "the said residential colonies"). The company other than M I D C shall not sell the water from the said river to any other person, firm or company, corporation or other body. In the event of the company selling water drawn from the said river then the Government without prejudice to its right will forthwith revoke the license. Government shall be entitled to recover from the company the proceeds of any such sale made by the company.

As regards water supply to M I D C this clause of resale of water will not be applicable to the extent of the water supplied by them to the industrial units and residential colonies in their jurisdiction. But, for any purpose other than the above, if M I D C desires to supply the water then the prior permission of the Government in Irrigation Department is obligatory. Water supply made by M I D C without prior permission will be charged at the maximum rates applicable for industrial water supply.

- (ii) If the said electronic measuring devices remain out of order for a period of exceeding 30 days then the quantity of water deemed to be drawn by the <u>USER</u> during the said period shall be taken 115% of the yearly sanctioned demand as communicated in clause no. 11 or average for the last six months whichever is higher. This will be made applicable for the period during which the measuring devices remained out of order.

 The aforesaid provisions will also apply when the quantity of water drawn by the company can not be measured on account of removal of the said electronic measuring devices for repairs or the same in the opinion of the Executive Engineer not working properly.
- (iii) If electronic meter meant for domestic or for agricultural use in not fitted or remains out of order or is removed the water charges will be levied as per the rates specified for the industrial use for the total quota as referred in clause 1(a) of this agreement.
- Billing should be done on bi-monthly monthly basis. The bill for the water drawn by the company during the previous calendar month shall be sent in duplicate / triplicate by the Executive Engineer to the office of the company within 15 days after the end of the water consumption months. The company shall thereafter duly pay the same by a demand draft drawn in the name of the Executive Engineer, Sangli Irrigation Division sangli for and on behalf of the Government within a fortnight from the date of receipt of the bill and shall not allow the same to fall in arrears. If the company fails to pay the amount within this stipulated time (15 days from the date of receipt of the bill that is before the end of current month) extra charge not exceeding 12% per annum of the amount due will be charged. If the delay in the payment of water charges exceed 6 months, the irrigation department reserves right to terminate the water supply with a notice of 15 days in advance.
- 10) The cost of all works in connection with arrangement for water supply including the cost of measuring devices and its installation and maintenance, shall be borne by the company.
- Subject to the provisions of clause (8) hereof the company shall pay to the Government at the time and in the manner specified in clause (12) hereof water charges for the quantity of water drawn by the company from said river as measured by said electronic measuring devices at following rates namely.

Here rates which are going to applied to the company with mention of purpose or use of water, sanctioned quota and present rate. The water lifted by the USER during rainy season from the river where Irrigation department has not released the water concessional rate as decided by the Irrigation department shall be charged.

- (i) Provided however that after expiry of two years from date of company starts drawing water from the said river if in any month the quantity of water drawn by the company is less than 90% of the quantity of water specified in clause (1) hereof then the company shall pay to the Government water charges calculated for 90 per cent of the quantity of water specified in clause (1) hereof or for average of the quantity of water drawn by the company during the period of previous three months including the month in question whichever is greater. (Not applicable to MIDC)
- (ii) For any unforeseen reason, if the company / agency would like to reduce /increase the demand of water made earlier / entered in the agreement they will be required to make the revised annual demand before commencement of the year that is 1st day of November. On acceptance of such revised demand the company will be charged as per changed demand for the period specified other condition remaining same. A <u>supplementary</u> agreement on hundred rupees stamp paper for this changed quantity which will form part of main agreement.
- (iii) No penal rate will be levied for the quantity limited 15% in excess of the sanctioned one. For quantity used in excess of this 15% without prior sanction a penal rate of 50% will be charged over the basic rate. The delay in payment on account of this also will be governed by clause (9) above.
- (iv) For any unforeseen reason (such as sudden closure of this units or sudden rise in production etc.). There could be abrupt fluctuation in the demand on the both sides. Such cases will be decided at Government level only by giving due consideration to the availability of water in the particulars sub-basin and so on.

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- (v) In addition to the payment of water charges referred to above the company shall also pay to the Government local fund cess at the rate of 20 paise <u>per every rupee of basic</u> water charges.
- (vi) Water bills: The bi-monthly bills for the period from November to August (for 10 months) shall be prepared on the basis of actual quantity of water lifted at the prevailing rate. The bill for the months of September and October (11th & 12th month) shall be prepared by taking review of annual sanctioned demand and the terms and conditions of the agreement and then shall be adjusted and paid accordingly. While adjusting so it shall be considered that the 90% of annual sanctioned demand has been lifted / used.

 The water lifted in excess up to 15% of sanctioned demand shall be charged at single rate and excess above 15% (without prior permission) will be charged at penal rate of 1.50 times of the normal rate as mentioned in the relevant clause. However the local cess shall be charged on single rate only..
- (a) The company shall pay to the Executive Engineer, water rates and local fund cess either in advance every bi-month's, on the basis of anticipated quantum of water to be drawn by it from the said source during the month's or on monthly basis within fifteen (15) days from the date of receipt of the bimonthly demands by the USER from the Executive Engineer. On default of the USER to pay the water rate or local funds cess as aforesaid vide clause 9 and 11 Government shall without prejudice to its any other rights and remedies be entitled to terminate this agreement forth with as per clause no. 9.
 - (b) In the case of disputes regarding quantity of water billed or rate at which the bill is prepared the company / firm / individual water user shall first pay the complete amount of the bill and then claim for the refund of any excess bill charges giving the reason / justification or wrong billing. However the decision of **Superintending Engineer**, **Sangli Irrigation Circle**, **Sangli** in this regards shall be final and binding on the company.
- Government hereby reserves to itself the right to revise from time to time the water rates and local funds cess and company shall pay the revised water rates and local fund cess as may be fixed by the Government from time to time.
- The USER shall not discharge the effluent in any Nalla or River and shall not pollute directly or indirectly any portion of the said Nala / River even by septic tank effluents. If any water sources are polluted by any industry as identified by Irrigation / Pollution Control Board / MIDC / MJP the company shall be charged with a penalty of rupees 5,000/- per such incident per day till its rectified. The opinion of Maharashtra Pollution Control Board in respect of degree of pollution will be binding on the company.

The company shall recycle the effluent water for their use such as gardening, recreation, cooling, cleaning, washing and manufacturing process etc. So that at least 50% reduction in consumption of fresh water is achieved.

- The effluent disposal arrangement made by the company / Industry shall be got approved by the company from the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board / Environment Department of the Government prior to commencing the operation pumping / drawing water from the source.
- The company shall at all times allow an officer of Irrigation Department of the Government authorized in the behalf to inspect the said works as well as the account and copies taken of entries from the records maintained by the company.
- Any notice or other documents to be given to or served upon the company may be given or served on behalf of the Government by the Executive Engineer, Sangh Arrigation Division, Sangli and any such notice or document shall be deemed to have been duty.



- All amounts due to the Government by the company under this agreement shall be deemed to be arrears of land revenue and may without prejudice to any other rights and remedies of the Government to be recovered from the company as arrears of land revenue.
- 20) On the expiry of the terms of this agreement, Government may renew this agreement within 90 days for such further period and on such terms and condition as Government may at its absolute discretion deem fit.
- The costs incurred in the execution of the incidental charges for this agreement including stamp duty shall be borne and paid by the company.
- Permission for extra water over and above the sanctioned quota will be granted only when the written permission for expansion etc. is produced by the company from the industrial department. (Not applicable for MIDC)
- 23) The agreement supercedes all the previous agreements (<u>except certain cases where MIDC</u>
 <u>has paid the Capital Contributation and entered into an agreement</u>) entered into by the
 USER with the Government in connection with supply of water from Krishana river
- 24) The Company should submit their water indent for every rotation to the Executive Engineer, Sangli Irrigation Division, Sangli, on or before starting of the rotation. The company should also furnish the exact quantity of water drawn in each rotation after completion of the rotation.
- The company will have to make an arrangement at it's own cost for adequate storage (Balance Tank) of not less than two months requirement of water in case of perenial canal, five months requirement in case of 8 monthly canal system, four months requirement. In case of water source from seasonal river/nalla and one month water requirement in case of perennial water source of river/nalla so as to take care of the closure period. But if unexpectedly the closure period is increased by more than the specified period stipulated herein the company will have to make an alternative arrangement for its water requirement at its own cost.
- 26) IF THE COMPANY COMMITS A BREACH OF ANY OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THEREOF GOVERNMENT SHALL BE ENTITLED TO CANCEL THIS PERMISSION AND DISCONTINUE THE SUPPLY OF WATER WITHOUT PAYMENT OF ANY COMPENSATION WHATSOWVER TO THE COMPANY
- 27) The Govt. hereby reserves to itself its rights to change/ amend/ modify/ cancel/ revise any of the terms and conditions, rules and regulations of water management And Maharashtra Irrigation Act and rules laid under them which shall be applicable for this agreement.

Terminal manholes shall be provided at the end of the collection system with arrangement for measuring the flow. No effluent shall be admitted in the pipes/sewers downstream of the terminal manholes. No effluent shall find its way other than in designed and provided collection system.
- 21. Neither storm water nor discharge from other premises shall be allowed to mix with the effluents from the factory.
- 22. The industry should not cause any nuisance in surrounding area.
- 23. The industry shall take adequate measures for control of noise levels from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standard in respect of noise to less than 75 dB (A) during day time and 70 dB (A) during night time. Day time is reckoned in between 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. and night time is reckoned between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- 24. The industry shall create the Environmental Cell by appointing an Environmental Engineer, Chemist and Agriculture expert for looking after day to day activities related to Environment and irrigation field where treated effluent is used for irrigation.





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- 25. The applicant shall provide ports in the chimney/(s) and facilities such as ladder, platform etc. for monitoring the air emissions and the same shall be open for inspection to/and for use of the Board's Staff. The chimney(s) vents attached to various sources of emission shall be designated by numbers such as S-1, S-2, etc. and these shall be painted/ displayed to facilitate identification.
- 26. The industry should comply with the Hazardous and Other Wastes (M & TM) Rules, 2016 and submit the Annual Returns as per Rule 6(5) & 20(2) of Hazardous and Other Wastes (M & TM) Rules, 2016 for the preceding year April to March in Form-IV by 30th June of every year.
- 27. The applicant shall install a separate meter showing the consumption of energy for operation of domestic and industrial effluent treatment plants and air pollution control system. A register showing consumption of chemicals used for treatment shall be maintained.
- 28. The applicant shall bring minimum 33% of the available open land under green coverage/ plantation. The applicant shall submit a yearly statement by 30th September every year on available open plot area, number of trees surviving as on 31st March of the year and number of trees planted by September end.
- 29. The Board reserves its rights to review plans, specifications or other data relating to plant setup for the treatment of waterworks for the purification thereof & the system for the disposal of sewage or trade effluent or in connection with the grant of any consent conditions.
- 30. The firm shall submit to this office, the 30th day of September every year, the Environment Statement Report for the financial year ending 31st March in the prescribed FORM-V as per the provisions of Rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) (second Amendment) Rules, 1992.
- 31. The Applicant shall obtain necessary prior permission for providing additional control equipment with necessary specifications and operation thereof or alteration or replacement/alteration well before its life come to an end or erection of new pollution control equipment.
- 32. The Board reserves its rights to vary all or any of the condition in the consent, if due to any technological improvement or otherwise such variation (including the change of any control equipment, other in whole or in part is necessary).
- 33. The applicant shall provide facility for collection of environmental samples and samples of trade and sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous waste to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf.

This has reference to your online proposal No.IA/MH/IND2/59911/2014 dated 27th January, 2019 for environmental clearance to the above project.

- 2. The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has examined the proposal for environmental clearance to the project for expansion of sugar plant from 6000 to 13000 TCD, co-generation power plant from 21 to 90 MW, and setting up molasses based distillery of 150 KLPD in existing area of 55 acres by M/s Shri Gurudatt Sugars Ltd at Gat No.61/A. Akiwat Takaliwadi Road, Taluka Shirol, District Kolhapur (Maharashtra).
- 3. The details of existing/proposed products are as under:-

- Existing land area is 222577 m2 (55 acres). No additional land shall be required for the proposed expansion. Green belt will be developed in 33% i.e. 73449 sqm out of the total project area. The estimated project cost is Rs.350 Crore. Total capital cost earmarked towards environmental pollution control measures is Rs.19.6 Crore and the recurring cost (O&M) will be about Rs.167.5 Lack per annum. Total Employment will be 300 persons as direct & 500 persons indirect.
- There are no National Parks, Wildlife Sanctuaries, Biosphere Reserves, Tiger/Elephant 5. Reserves and Wildlife Corridors etc. within 10 km distance from the project site. Krishna River flows at distance of 4 km in the West.
- Total fresh water requirement of 760 m3/day is proposed to be met from Krishna River. Approval in this regard has been obtained from the Chief Engineer, Irrigation Department, Kolhapur (Maharashtra).

Effluent of 1300 m3/day from sugar and co-gen unit will be treated through ETP consisting of primary, secondary and tertiary treatment units, followed by Condensate Polishing Unit. The effluent of 1350 m3/day from distillery unit will be sent to MEE, and the concentrated spent wash would be fed to incineration boiler. There will be no discharge of treated/untreated waste water from the unit, and thus ensuring Zero Liquid Discharge.

Two multi fuel boilers of 120 TPH capacity each and one Multi fuel boiler of 60 TPH will be installed. Electrostatic Precipitator with a stack of height of 70 m each for 120 TPH capacity boiler and 90 m for 60 TPH boiler will be installed to control the particulate emissions within the statutory limits of 150 mg/Nm³.

- 7. The project/activity is covered under category A of item 5 (g) 'Distilleries', 1(d) 'Thermal Power Plants' and category B of item 5(j) 'Sugar Industry' of the Schedule to the EIA Notification, 2006 and requires consideration at central level in the Ministry.
- **8.** Standard Terms of Reference for the project was granted on 17th August, 2017. Public hearing was conducted by the State Pollution Control Board on 5th December 2018.
- 9. The proposal for environmental clearance was considered by the EAC (Industry-2) in its meetings held on 8-9 April, 2019. The project proponent and their consultant presented the EIA/EMP report. The Committee found the EIA/EMP report to be satisfactory, complying with the ToR, and recommended the project for grant of environmental clearance.
- 10. Based on the proposal submitted by the project proponent and recommendations of the EAC (Industry-2), Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change hereby accords environmental clearance to the project for expansion of sugar plant from 6000 to 13000 TCD, co-generation power plant from 21 to 90 MW, and setting up molasses based distillery of 150 KLPD by M/s Shri Gurudatt Sugars Ltd at Gat No.61/A, Akiwat Takaliwadi Road, Taluka Shirol, District Kolhapur (Maharashtra), under the provisions of the EIA Notification, 2006, and the amendments therein, subject to compliance of the terms and conditions as under:-
- (a) Prior approval shall be obtained from PESO for site and layout plan of storage facilities (Petroleum storage Class A installation).
- (b) Necessary permission as mandated under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as applicable from time to time, shall be obtained from the State Pollution Control Board as required.
- (c) As already committed by the project proponent, Zero Liquid Discharge shall be ensured and no waste/treated water shall be discharged outside the premises.
- (d) Necessary authorization required under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Trans-Boundary Movement) Rules, 2016, Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 shall be obtained and the provisions contained in the Rules shall be strictly adhered to.
- (e) To control source and the fugitive emissions, suitable pollution control devices shall be installed to meet the prescribed norms and/or the NAAQS. The gaseous emissions shall be dispersed through stack of adequate height as per CPCB/SPCB guidelines.
- (f) Coal less than 0.5% sulphur content shall be used as fuel in boiler.



- (g) Total fresh water requirement shall not exceed 760 cum/day proposed to be met from Krishna River. Prior permission shall be obtained from the concerned regulatory authority/CGWA in this regard.
- (h) Hazardous chemicals shall be stored in tanks, tank farms, drums, carboys etc. Flame arresters shall be provided on tank farm and the solvent transfer through pumps.
- (i) Process organic residue and spent carbon, if any, shall be sent to cement industries. ETP sludge, process inorganic & evaporation salt shall be disposed off to the TSDF.
- (j) The Company shall strictly comply with the rules and guidelines under Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals (MSIHC) Rules, 1989 as amended time to time. All transportation of Hazardous Chemicals shall be as per the Motor Vehicle Act (MVA), 1989.
- (k) The company shall undertake waste minimization measures as below:-
 - (i) Metering and control of quantities of active ingredients to minimize waste.
 - (ii) Reuse of by-products from the process as raw materials or as raw material substitutes in other processes.
 - (iii) Use of automated filling to minimize spillage.
 - (iv) Use of Close Feed system into batch reactors.
 - (v) Venting equipment through vapour recovery system.
 - (vi) Use of high pressure hoses for equipment clearing to reduce wastewater generation.
- (I) The green belt of 5-10 m width shall be developed in more than 33% of the total project area, mainly along the plant periphery, in downward wind direction, and along road sides etc. Selection of plant species shall be as per the CPCB guidelines in consultation with the State Forest Department.
- (m) All the commitments made regarding issues raised during the public hearing/consultation meeting shall be satisfactorily implemented.
- (n) At least 0.75% of the total project cost shall be allocated for Corporate Environment Responsibility (CER) and item-wise details along with time bound action plan shall be prepared and submitted to the Ministry's Regional Office.
- (o) For the DG sets, emission limits and the stack height shall be in conformity with the extant regulations and the CPCB guidelines. Acoustic enclosure shall be provided to DG set for controlling the noise pollution.
- (p) The unit shall make the arrangement for protection of possible fire hazards during manufacturing process in material handling. Fire fighting system shall be as per the norms.
- (q) Occupational health surveillance of the workers shall be done on a regular basis and records maintained as per the Factories Act.
- (r) There shall be adequate space inside the plant premises earmarked for parking of vehicles for raw materials and finished products, and no parking to be allowed outside on public places.
- (s) Storage of raw materials shall be done either in silos or covered areas to prevent dust pollution and other fugitive emissions.

- (t) Continuous online (24x7) monitoring system for stack emissions shall be installed for measurement of flue gas discharge and the pollutants concentration, and the data to be transmitted to the CPCB and SPCB server. For online continuous monitoring of effluent, the unit shall install web camera with night vision capability and flow meters in the channel/drain carrying effluent within the premises.
- (u) CO₂ generated from the process shall be bottled/made solid ice and sold to authorized vendors.
- (v) There shall be adequate space inside the plant premises earmarked for parking of vehicles for raw materials and finished products, and no parking to be allowed outside on public places.
- **10.1** The grant of Environmental Clearance is further subject to compliance of other generic conditions as under:-
- (i) The project authorities must strictly adhere to the stipulations made by the state Pollution Control Board (SPCB), State Government and/ or any other statutory authority.
- (ii) No further expansion or modifications in the plant shall be carried out without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change. In case of deviations or alterations in the project proposal from those submitted to this Ministry for clearance, a fresh reference shall be made to the Ministry to assess the adequacy of conditions imposed and to add additional environmental protection measures required, if any.
- (iii) The locations of ambient air quality monitoring stations shall be decided in consultation with the State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) and it shall be ensured that at least one stations each is installed in the upwind and downwind direction as well as where maximum ground level concentrations are anticipated.
- (iv) The National Ambient Air Quality Emission Standards issued by the Ministry vide G.S.R. No. 826(E) dated 16th November, 2009 shall be complied with.
- (v) The overall noise levels in and around the plant area shall be kept well within the standards by providing noise control measures including acoustic hoods, silencers, enclosures etc. on all sources of noise generation. The ambient noise levels shall conform to the standards prescribed under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 Rules, 1989 viz. 75 dBA (day time) and 70 dBA (night time).
- (vi) The Company shall harvest rainwater from the roof tops of the buildings to recharge ground water, and to utilize the same for different industrial operations within the plant.
- (vii) Training shall be imparted to all employees on safety and health aspects of chemicals handling. Pre-employment and routine periodical medical examinations for all employees shall be undertaken on regular basis.
- (viii) The company shall comply with all the environmental protection measures and safeguards proposed in the documents submitted to the Ministry. All the recommendations made in the EIA/EMP in respect of environmental management, risk mitigation measures and public hearing shall be implemented.

- (ix) The company shall undertake all measures for improving socio-economic conditions of the surrounding area. CSR activities shall be undertaken by involving local villagers, administration and other stake holders. Also eco-developmental measures shall be undertaken for overall improvement of the environment.
- (x) A separate Environmental Management Cell equipped with full-fledged laboratory facilities shall be set up to carry out the Environmental Management and Monitoring functions.
- (xi) The company shall earmark sufficient funds towards capital cost and recurring cost per annum to implement the conditions stipulated by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change as well as the State Government along with the implementation schedule for all the conditions stipulated herein. The funds so earmarked for environment management/pollution control measures shall not be diverted for any other purpose.
- (xii) A copy of the clearance letter shall be sent by the project proponent to concerned Panchayat, Zila Parishad/ Municipal Corporation, Urban local Body and the local NGO, if any, from whom suggestions/ representations, if any, were received while processing the proposal.
- (xiii) The project proponent shall also submit six monthly reports on the status of compliance of the stipulated Environmental Clearance conditions including results of monitored data (both in hard copies as well as by e-mail) to the respective Regional Office of MoEF&CC, the respective Zonal office of CPCB and SPCB. A copy of Environmental Clearance and six monthly compliance status report shall be posted on the website of the company.
- (xiv) The environmental statement for each financial year ending 31st March in Form-V as is mandated shall be submitted to the concerned State Pollution Control Board as prescribed under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, as amended subsequently, shall also be put on the website of the company along with the status of compliance of environmental clearance conditions and shall also be sent to the respective Regional offices of MoEF&CC by e-mail.
- (xv) The project proponent shall inform the public that the project has been accorded environmental clearance by the Ministry and copies of the clearance letter are available with the SPCB/Committee and may also be seen at Website of the Ministry at http://moef.nic.in. This shall be advertised within seven days from the date of issue of the clearance letter, at least in two local newspapers that are widely circulated in the region of which one shall be in the vernacular language of the locality concerned and a copy of the same shall be forwarded to the concerned Regional office of the Ministry.
- 11. The Ministry reserves the right to stipulate additional conditions, if found necessary at subsequent stages and the project proponent shall implement all the said conditions in a time bound manner. The Ministry may revoke or suspend the environmental clearance, if implementation of any of the above conditions is not found satisfactory.
- **12.** The above conditions will be enforced, inter-alia under the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the Air (Prevention & Control of Water Pollution) Act, 1981, the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991, read with subsequent amendments therein.
